

# Summergrove Tennis Team Rules 2011

## A. Non-Resident Teams:

1. Captain must submit written request to start a team out of Summergrove.
  - a. Team will need to be approved by committee.
  - b. Captain shall submit roster 2 weeks prior to USTA and ALTA deadlines, and identify non-residents on roster form, prior to season start.
  - c. Key to open courts will be handled on an "as needed" basis.

## B. Resident Teams:

1. A Team shall be deemed a Resident Team, if captained by a resident & with 50% residents on a team.
2. Summergrove teams have priority over non-resident teams, for registering each season.

## C. All Teams:

2. Captain shall submit **one check**, payable to Summergrove HOA, **for entire team prior to season start**.
  - a. \$35 per person, per season for non-resident players on roster.
  - b. Any non-resident members that are added on to roster after start, can make check payable to Summergrove HOA for \$35 per person.
3. Teams are entitled to 1 practice session a wk for 2 hours-2 courts. Practice Day & courts are assigned.
4. Teams are entitled to 5 courts to start for match play, unless 2 teams are scheduled at the same time.
5. If match play has started on any and all courts, and a resident wishes to play, the team has priority for the courts. Match play will not be interrupted and residents may take the first available court.
6. If 2 teams are scheduled for play on the same day and time, each team will be provided with 3 courts to start. 2 courts shall be left open for residents. The gazebo picnic area can be traded off week to week, for each team to use. This is worked out amongst each captain as to what day they will use it.
7. Make up matches for rain outs shall try to be made up during practice time.
8. Proper attire and appropriate language and behavior is expected on the courts & facilities.
9. Captain is responsible for promoting good sportsmanlike behavior.
10. Please recycle as needed in proper recycle bin and empty overflow from big rubbish bin near gazebo. Also, please empty rubbish baskets on courts after match play, as they fill up and another team may play the next day. You can take to large dumpster in parking lot located near street.
11. Please turn off lights after your use.

## **Summergrove Tennis Teams – General Guidelines**

1. Summergrove tennis courts have the capacity to hold up to 12 teams per season.
2. The committee has decided to cap at 8 teams each: 4 men's & 4 Ladies per season.
3. Practice nights with the capacity of 8 teams:
  - a. M-Th: Can hold up to 2 teams a night, 2 courts each team, for 2 hours.
  - b. If teams are playing on the same day/time, Summergrove teams have priority over the upper courts, with the other team taking the lower courts.
4. Courts 2, 3, 4 will be reserved for Match play.
5. If Teams do not pay non-resident fees, and / or exhibits unsportsmanlike behavior, the committee has the right to eliminate them from future team play.
